Events will be run as heats (20+ boats) and gold, silver and bronze medals awarded to the fastest 3 times in all junior events. In senior and masters events only gold medals will be awarded in each category.

Age Groups are those that a participant will race in at the 2026 SA Schools Championships or SA Championships events. Masters events are open to all age categories but where there are few entries in age categories races will be combined with similar age categories. The software allows different categories to be displayed on the screen at the same time. Masters should indicate their age category when doing entries

Entry of participants should be in performance rank order so that heats can be seeded.

Names of participants in team events is not necessary. It is expected that participants are in the correct age groups. Participants may row up an age group i.e. U15 may row in U16, but may not row down an age group. Please indicate the number of team you would like in each team event.

Entries close 9:00am Monday 8th September 2025. After this time no late entries will be accepted.

Schools and Clubs will be provided wrist bands for competitors which will allow them free entry at the gates. Wrist bands will be allocated based on entries received by 9am Monday 9th September. Anyone not wearing a wrist band will be charged an entry fee at the gates.

Estimated finish time 2:00-3:00pm

The Spring Festival will be run as a cashless event. There is an entry fee for adults and spectators for the Spring Festival.
