- Competitors, coaches, and staff: Free

Race Entries:

- **Closing Date:** Entries close at 17:00 on 17th February and must be submitted online at www.regatta.co.za.
- **Late Entries:** Late entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis **only if there are empty lanes in existing events**. If no lanes are available, the entry will not be accepted.
- **Note:** Composite club crews are not permitted.

Order of Events:

- The organisers reserve the right to alter the order of events in consultation with the Gauteng Schools Rowing Federation and school representatives.
- **Club captains and coaches:** Please pay attention to race intervals outlined in the draft programme and plan crew entries and boat allocations accordingly.
- **Important:** Start times will not be delayed to accommodate crew or boat clashes.





- Changes to the order of events, if necessary, will be made only in consultation with club representatives.

Weather Interruptions:

- In the event of adverse weather, the President of the Jury will decide on safety measures and determine if racing should continue as scheduled.
- If delays occur, the schedule will be adjusted where possible.
- If events cannot be completed, the President of the Jury will consult with the GSRF Executive and member school representatives to decide on reducing the number of events.

Catering:

- Food and refreshments will be available for purchase throughout the day.
